John Dunbar reported that the snow equipment is near complete. President Frome highlighted from the Water Utility report offered by Dean Smith

Police Chief's Report:

Chief Shawn Bauer mentioned that he hired 2 new part time officers. He also mentioned that he purchased a defibrillator unit with the \$1000.00 grant from Enbridge Inc. Chief Bauer noted that there were 85 incidents that his department dealt with last month

(c) (Schafer)(Day) was carried to clarify and amend the previously approved Sewer Utility residential rate decrease by reducing the \$16.10 charge, for the first 1667 gallons by the same percentage that the \$9.66 rate is decreased, therefore amending the first 1667 gallons to \$15.58

(d) (Pokallus)(Toufar) was carried on a unanimous roll call vote to approve Final Resolution for the Hwy 98 Sidewalk Improvements Project

(e) (Hagen)(Maurer) was carried on a unanimous roll call vote to approve <u>Resolution 2014-</u> <u>07</u> - A RESOLUTION AMENDING THE 2014 ADOPTED BUDGET TO REPURPOSE MONIES FROM COMMITTED FUND BALANCES FOR SPECIFIC 2014 PROJECTS
