ATV/UTV ORDINANCE IN SPENCER

On July 10th, the Village Board passed an ordinance to allow operating all-terrain vehicles (ATV) and utility terrain vehicles (UTV) on village roadways except State HWY 13, State HWY 98 and County HWY C. You are allowed to cross these 3 roads at an intersection. You are not allowed to travel on private roads, driveways, or on any private property without permission. Operators must observe a speed limit of 15 miles per hour, and be registered and operate according to



Wisconsin State Statues. The ordinance will be enforced by any Wisconsin law enforcement officer.

Safety is the number one concern. Do your part to keep this privilege in the village.

GOLF CARTS IN SPENCER

On August 14th, the Village Board passed an ordinance to allow registered golf carts to be operated on village roadways except County HWY C, State HWYs 13 and 98, and any street where the posted speed limit is more than 35 miles per hour. You are allowed to cross these roads at an intersection. Operators must have a valid driver's license. A learner's permit, revoked, or suspended license is not considered valid. Golf carts must be registered with the Spencer Police Department and meet certain criteria. No golf cart may be operated at a speed in excess of 15 miles per hour. They may not be operated on any sidewalk, in parks, or other trails and no more passengers are allowed than the golf cart passenger capacity. You can read the entire ordinance at spencerwi.org. LONG RANGE PLANNING

The village is working on two long range plans to help plan for future growth and development and to make recreational improvements in the village.

Comprehensive Plan



The first plan is the Comprehensive Plan update. The Village of Spencer's comprehensive plan is intended to guide village decision-makers, property owners, developers, civic and non-profit organizations and community members in the growth, development, and improvement of the Village of Spencer. The State of Wisconsin requires that the village update the plan every 10 years. This plan outlines where the village currently is, as well as where we want the village to be in the future. The

Village Planning Commission has been working on this document for several months. The Village Board will hold a <u>Public Hearing on October 9th at 6:00 p.m.</u> at the Village Complex for residents to give their input. A copy of the draft comprehensive plan is available online at spencerwi.org, and can be viewed at the Village Office.

Comprehensive Outdoor Recreation Plan

The second plan that the village is working on is a Comprehensive Outdoor Recreation Plan. This plan outlines what recreational opportunities the village currently has and identifies the future recreational needs of the village. A survey of

residents was conducted a few years back to help understand what the village was doing well in terms of outdoor recreation, and what improvements the village needed to undertake. One of the most identified issues in the survey was the need for bike/walking trails. With the completion of this plan, the village will qualify for state grant assistance to help fund recreational activities. This will allow the village to accomplish more, in terms of providing recreational opportunities for our residents, without increasing tax revenue.



ORDINANCE REMINDERS

§ 451-19 Parking regulations.

The following parking limitations are provided for on the following designated streets:

- A. There shall be no parking on the east side of School Street from Main Street to Elm Street between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m. when school is in session.
- B. There shall be no parking at any time on the following streets other than temporary parking for the purpose of picking up children at the school:
 - 1) South side of Main Street from Douglas Street to School Street.
 - 2) South side of Mill Street from Douglas Street to School Street.
 - 3) North side of Pine Street from Douglas Street to School Street.
 - 4) South side of Elm Street from Douglas Street to School Street.
- C. Between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m. parking shall be limited to two hours on the following streets when school is in session:
 - 1) The west side of School Street from Main Street to Elm Street.
 - 2) Both sides of Douglas Street from East Clark Street to Elm Street.
 - 3) The north side of Main Street from School Street to Pacific Street.
 - 4) The south side of Main Street from Douglas Street to Pacific Street.
 - 5) The north side of Mill Street from School Street to Pacific Street.
 - 6) The south side of Mill Street from Douglas Street to Pacific Street.
 - 7) The south side of Pine Street from School Street to Pacific Street.
 - 8) The north side of Pine Street from Douglas Street to Pacific Street.
 - 9) The north side of Elm Street from School Street to Pacific Street.



L. There shall be no parking on the East Side of South Haslow Street (**This is a NEW Ordinance**)

§ 451-23Winter parking.

No person shall **park** any vehicle on any street in the Village of Spencer between the hours of 2:00 a.m. and 6:00 a.m. during the period from November 1 through April 1.

VILLAGE REVOLVING LOAN FUND

The Village Community Development Block Grant–Revolving Loan Fund is set up to assist low to moderate income residents. Loans are available to provide home owners with a means to return a home to a decent, safe and sanitary condition. The program is not intended to help remodel or beautify a home. These loans to homeowners are interest free and do not need to be repaid until the property is sold or transferred. To qualify you must have a income of less than the following:
