President Frome called the meeting to order at 6:30.

The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

## Roll Call

Trustees Hoes, Carolfi, Schafer, Wienke, and Toufar were present.

## Approval of Minutes

(Wienke)(Toufar) was carried to dispense with the reading of the previous meeting minutes and approve them as printed.

## Public Comments

Jordan Buss spoke on the Village collaborating with the School on a FEMA Grant for tornado dome to be incorporated with the proposed School Construction Project.

## Public Works' Report

Paul Hensch reported on the progress of the North LaSalle project and the Hickory/Truman project. He also reported on a review of the design flaw on the stairway on the new holding tank. He concluded with reporting that a water main was never installed properly on Peach Street, and that the crew was able to identify the problem and fix it.

## Police Chief's Report

Chief Bauer reported that the officers handled 205 calls for service, issued 80 traffic citations, 9 municipal citations, and 25 written warnings. The department investigated 3 traffic accidents.

President Frome did not have a report.

## Old Business

President Frome appointed Alan Jicinsky as a Village Trustee with consent from the Village Board.

#### New Business

Discussion was held on Village Ordinance 271-3 Destruction of Noxious Weeds and Ordinance 271-4 Regulation of Length of Lawn and Grasses. No action was taken.

(Toufar)(Carolfi) was carried by a roll call vote with Hoes, Carolfi, Schafer, Wienke, Toufar, and Frome voting for, and Jicinsky abstaining, on Pay Request #3 from Melvin for the N LaSalle St Project for \$36,067.77.

(Schafer)(Hoes) was carried by a roll call vote with Hoes, Carolfi, Schafer, Wienke, Toufar, and Frome voting for, and Jicinsky abstaining, on Change Order #1 from Switlick for the Hickory/Truman Project.

(Schafer)(Wienke) was carried by unanimous roll call vote to approve Pay request #2 from Switlick for the Hickory/Truman Project for \$388,737.50.

(Carolfi)(Hoes) was carried by unanimous roll call vote to approve Pay request #5 from Stabb for the WWTP Project for \$589,005.52.

(Carolfi)(Hoes) was carried to authorize the Village Administrator to sell the old Ford F-350.

(Hoes)(Schafer) was carried to pay \$1,658 for the installation cost of new gutters and a new door for Spencer Kids Group.

(Carolfi)(Wienke) was carried to purchase Chromebooks for the Village Trustees and Administrator for a price of \$2,232.

Discussion was held on scheduling more Village Board Meetings. No action was taken.

(Wienke)(Toufar) was carried to approve the application for a Operator's License for Mark Nagel and Noelle Wallace.

(Schafer)(Hoes) was carried by unanimous roll call vote to approve payment of current vouchers.
