He continued to report on a watermain break by the Village Complex, and a ferric chloride spill in the wastewater treatment plant, that was contained, caused by the delivery driver.

Officer Bauer reported that, in February, officers handled 93 calls for service and conducted 69 traffic stops. Officers issued 25 traffic citations, 3 municipal citations and 50 warnings.
