Motion by Kilty, seconded by Staples was carried to approve the minutes as read. Motion by Pokallus, seconded by Frome was carried to add Ayres Associates to the paragraph in regards to placing Water and Sewer main on West Cedar Street.

Mary Baumann representing First Choice Recycling asked if the Village Clerk would sign an application so their business could receive a salvage permit. Baumann related the main reason for doing this was to have junk vehicles for the Fire Department to use for training purposes.
